

Have an Android device read text aloud:



1) Go to the Settings app



2) Click Accessibility



3) Click Select to Speak



- Allow "Select to Speak" to have full control of your device?

 The full control permission is appropriate for apps that help you with accessibility needs, but not for most apps.

 View and control screen
 it can read all content on the screen and display content over other apps.

 View and perform actions

 Tracks your interactions with an app or a hardware sensor, and interacts with apps on your behalf.

- 4) Turn on the Select to Speak shortcut. Then click "Allow" or "OK"
- 5) This "Accessibility" icon will appear at the bottom right side of the screen.
 Click it whenever you want to turn on Select to Speak.
- 6) Select the text that you want to read aloud.



 Clink in the center icon to pause or restart the voice.
 Use the arrows to move back or forward.
