NN: What were your first thoughts when you saw your babies?

**Merle:** My first thoughts were omg are they gonna be okay? They are so little! I'm so in love!

NN: What was the greatest challenge for you as a NICU parent?

**Merle:** My greatest challenge was learning that I have to take care of myself so that I can be there for my girls. I was at the NICU twice a day until I got sick. Being a parent is hard but being a single parent is something else.

NN: What is life like now, after the NICU?

**Merle:** Life is crazy now lol. The girls are so spunky. I fall in love with them DAILY and they teach me as well. They have made me a better woman and taught me more discipline. They are full of love and life and SO MUCH energy lol. Unless I told you, you would never know they started at 2 lbs and 3lbs.

NN: What advice do you have for current NICU families?

**Merle:** The best advice that I can give is to never compare your NICU journey to anyone else's journey. Every baby is different and will move at their own pace so don't get discouraged. Also make sure you take care of you. Your little one(s) are in the best place they can be to get well and come home with you. Remember that it's not your fault that they are finishing outside the belly. You did the best you could.
