To our Industry Partners:

Effective December 1, 2019, Indiana University applies a 36% indirect cost rate to all costs associated with industry-sponsored clinical studies. This rate is calculated on the total costs of the study, except for the following specific fees:

- Indiana University IRB Fees
- Office of Clinical Research (OCR) Fees

When funds are spent for any clinical study costs, procedures, salaries, services, participant stipends etc., the indirect cost rate is automatically applied to each transaction. This includes all payments and purchases made on behalf of the Sponsor or CRO.

Indirect costs are those costs incurred for a common or joint purpose, and not readily assignable to a specific project. Project specific administration and facility costs are not recovered within the 36% indirect rate and will be negotiated as direct costs within the budget.
